Path of Hope, Inc. was founded in 1976 as a Halfway House for male alcoholics, operated as such until 1981, then was licensed as a Chemical Dependency Treatment Center. In 1983, a facility for the treatment of female alcoholics was opened. In 2009 and 2020 we were given an opportunity to expand our services once again. We now have 3 halfway houses, one in Lexington and two in Asheboro, NC. The addition of these halfway houses will allow us to give a greater service to men and women that desire a life of sobriety.

Path of Hope, Inc. is a private, nonprofit corporation 501(c)3, chartered by the State of North Carolina as a tax deductible charity. We are governed by a 12 member Board of Directors. The members of the Board of Directors are interested in and willing to work at combating the disease of addiction.

ADMISSION PROCEDURES and REQUIREMENTS

- All applicants for admission shall be required to provide a complete set of treatment records which will include psychosocial history
- Presenting substance abuse and/or mental health diagnosis
- TB screening results (last 6 months)
- Recent physical (last 30 days)
- All applicants will be interviewed before acceptance into our halfway house program.
- Must furnish proof of participation in a licensed substance abuse program.

- Two weeks rent due at time of acceptance into program (\$125.00 per week)
- On the first day of admission new residents will complete an intake with a Substance Abuse Counselor
- Must be able to maintain employment and/or full time education.
- Must have social security card and driver's license or state ID.
- Must agree to participate in halfway house program for a minimum of six months.
- All residents must be willing to do volunteer work in the community.
